- International Student Barometer (ISB) survey from the Autumn 2023
- A total of oven 120 000 students from 137 universities across the globe answered

Buddy Program - You are guaranteed to make friends

The Buddy Programme is a community at Umeå University that introduces international students to Sweden and helps them to settle in Umeå.

- A buddy group consists of approximately 8–10 buddies and 25–30 international students.
- The Buddy Programme involves the possibility to participate in a variety of fun social activities, for example sports, parties and travel, or just having a cup of coffee with your group members.
- The Buddy Programme starts at the beginning of the semester and lasts through the semester.

- All though incoming students come to us within an agreement with the language department they are welcome to apply for courses in any subject as long as they meet the eligibility requirement for the particular course.
- If you have previous knowledge of Swedish you may also apply to courses taught in Swedish.



Swedish

We offer both part-time beginners courses in Swedish called *Swedish for international students* and intensiv courses in Swedish.

For the intensive courses you need to have previous knowledge of Swedish to be eligible.



Svenska

- Students that have reached B2 level of Swedish knowledge meet the eligibility requirement for Swedish knowledge to apply for courses offered in Swedish at Umeå university.
- Students that have reached C1 level of Swedish knowledge meet the eligibility requirement for Swedish knowledge to apply for courses offered in Svenska/Nordiska språk in Swedish at Umeå university.
